VII	=	Ratification; attestation

Amendments:

1-10	=	Bill of Rights
12,20,22,23,25	=	Presidency
11	=	Judiciary (suits against states)
17, 20, 27	=	Congress (elections, terms, \$\$\$)
13, 14, 15	=	Ending slavery; civil rights
15, 19, 24, 26	=	Voting rights (race, gender, \$\$\$, age)
16	=	Income tax
18, 21	=	Prohibition

Bill of Rights:

1 st	=	religion; speech; press; assembly; grievance
2 nd	=	individual right to bear arms
3 rd	=	quartering of soldiers
4 th	=	searches
5 th	=	grand jury; dbl jeopardy; self-incrimination; due process; private property; takings
6 th	=	speedy public jury trial; witnesses; attorney
7 th	=	civil jury trial
8 th	=	excess fines & bail; cruel punishment
9 th	=	individual rights not limited
10 th	=	fed rights limited, rest left to states/people
